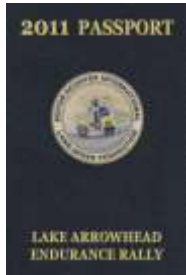




## LAKE ARROWHEAD 6-HOUR ENDURANCE RALLY PROTOCOL

1. You **MUST** Carry and maintain an official **authenticated** event-specific Rally Passport. This consists of a duly issued MSILSF Lake Arrowhead 6-Hour Endurance Rally Passport, stamped with the MSILSF 2011 Authentication Stamp. You are responsible for removing your Passport from the plastic protector in order to receive a check-point stamp.



2. The rally will begin and finish from the Saddleback Inn, Lake Arrowhead, CA. Prior to departing the Saddleback Inn at the start of the rally, you must obtain the MSILSF Lake Arrowhead 6-Hour Rally **Starter Stamp** on your Passport.



3. On the lap of your choice you must deposit the pre-stamped/pre-addressed **authenticated MSILSF/Lake Arrowhead Postcard issued to you with your name and Rider Number** in the mail at the United States Post Office, 27177 State Highway #189, Blue Jay, CA 92317.



4. On the laps of your choice, you must obtain two (2) **Completed Lap Stamps** on your Rally Passport from the MSILSF Customs Agent in the Saddleback Inn lobby.





5. On the lap of your choice you must purchase gasoline from Blue Jay 76, 27243 State Highway #189, Blue Jay, CA 92317, obtain a legible/dated paper receipt for gasoline purchase, and submit said receipt to the MSILSF Customs Agent at the conclusion of the rally.

6. This rally ends precisely at 1400 hours PDT, at or after which time you must obtain the MSILSF Lake Arrowhead 6-Hour **Finisher Stamp** on your Passport from the MSILSF Customs Agent, who will affix her/his signature, together with the time.



7. The rider in each displacement class who has completed the most miles based on starting and finishing odometer readings will be declared the 1<sup>st</sup> Place Winner for said class, and receive a trophy. Standings for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and beyond will be recorded in the official MSILSF records.

8. Rider's must complete rally laps around Lake Arrowhead on State Highway #173 and/or North Bay Road. Rally laps may be ridden clockwise, counter-clockwise, or a combination thereof.



9. Vehicle Code violation citations issued by the California Highway Patrol or the San Bernardino County Sheriff must be reported to the MSILSF Customs Agent immediately at the close of the rally. A citation for a moving violation, such as speeding/unsafe speed, unsafe passing, DUI or reckless driving, may subject the rider to disqualification.
